**Student and youth groups are exempt from the new border crossing rules.**

**Students Born in the United States**

**Students will need a Certified Birth Certificate**

*This is the one from Kent County or whichever county your child was born in. It is not the one from the hospital*

**Students will need a pictured I.D.**

*This can be a school issued one, one from a health club or a state issued I.D. State issued I.D.s can be obtained from your local Secretary of State office and take about six weeks to receive*

**or**

**If they have one, they may use their passport**

**Foreign-Born Students**

**Students or those who are not U.S. Citizens, will need to call the following numbers to find out what documentation they will need to successfully enter Canada and then re-enter the United States.**
